

The Framework Agreement 2014 and the Framework Agreement Guide 2014 were both published in March 2015 to meet the needs of the public sector in Scotland on an interim basis prior to the publication of the next JCT edition. This 2014 Edition is designed to comply with the requirements of the public procurement rules, as set out in the Consolidated Directive (2004/18/EC) and as implemented in Scotland by The Public Contracts (Scotland) Regulations 2012 (SSI 2012/88) and with the general EC Treaty principles to which public bodies must have regard.

SBCC published online amendment sheets for its 2011 edition of contracts, covering the CDM Regulations 2015, which are effective from 6 April 2015. These enable parties to incorporate the statutory provisions into both current and future contracts.
